The building is a partnership project with the City and County of Swansea, Welsh Assembly Government and the local community, funded through European Union objective one monies and has specific types of business it can support. It has to provide support to new and/or expanding local business creating jobs for the Gorseinon area,

The trust will over the next week be sending out application forms to perspective tenants.
