

Gorseinon's Town has always been at a crossroads which makes it an ideal location in which to conduct business. The Romans first saw the potential of the area in setting up training camps and eventually a fort at Loughor, the crossing point into Carmarthenshire.

Medieval monks moved into the area in the 12th century establishing a grist mill on the site we now know as Monks Mill Parc Melin Mynach. From the 17th century industry developed utilising the area's natural resources, the coal from the mountains and the easy access to the sea via tram ways and railways down to Swansea and the Burry Estuary.

The scars of heavy industry have faded now with the closure of the last works in 2001 and the reclamation of the land which has now become the location of the Canolfan Gorseinon Centre.

But location is still just as important, situated between the mountains and the sea, Gorseinon sits 5 minutes off Junction 47 of the M4 equidistant between Cardiff and Haverfordwest making it the ideal location for South Wales gatherings, regional meetings and exhibitions.

With free accessible parking Canolfan Gorseinon Centre sits at the cross roads for business in South Wales.

Gorseinon Development Trust

The Gorseinon Development Trust was established following the closure of the Corus Bryngwyn works in 2001, the last remnants of heavy industry in Gorseinon. The Trust plays a key role in developing regeneration initiatives and opportunities for people living and working in the area.

The Trust became a charity in 2008 and aims to Secure a Strong Economic Base for the Local Community.

It aims to create employment and income generation opportunities through the development of social enterprises which will operate through the Canolfan Gorseinon Centre.

Unlocking Potential

It aims to break down barriers, build opportunities to engage people living and working in the wider Gorseinon area, allowing them to participate in regeneration initiatives and unlock their potential for employment, increasing confidence and ensuring skills are maximised.

Creating a Place Where People Want to Live and Work

It aims to create and develop networks and working partnerships to support local regeneration and in particular, a strong working relationship with the Local Authority. Ensuring initiatives meet the needs of the community and are developed and delivered in an environmentally sustainable way.

Securing a Sustainable Future

It aims to maintain independence, to ensure so far as is reasonably practicable, that the organisation remains democratic with strong local governance that continues to reflect both the diversity of the communities and to articulate the consensus view. To enable the Trust to become economically sustainable through asset development and social enterprises.

The trust operates a membership scheme which provide opportunities for discounts on the services we offer out of our centre.
